Squid is the flagship product of Great-Circle. It has been created to aggregate all weather informations in a single software.

What Squid has to offer:

- Lots of weather forecast files (called GRIB files)
- Weather charts
- Satellite images (made by Great-Circle)
- Weather observations
- Race tracer
- Routing (i.e. "boat GPS navigation")
- A unique and straightforward user interface
- Available on Windows, iOS and Android.

Today Squid is **used by thousand of skippers** around the world. The desktop application is our biggest platform. A huge majority of the professional sailing boats and performance oriented cruising vessels around the world are using our product.

Great-Circle is going to **launch a new cross-platform desktop application** « Squid 2 » along with a redesign of the **web application** and a new public API to access our data from third party applications.

These new products are **based on the latest technologies and framework**. They will integrate a new UX and new features.

BACK-END DEVELOPER POSITION

You will be responsible of building core features of the new Squid API and help develop/test new routing algorithms. You will collaborate with a small team of 2-3 people with complementary skills.

You will have the opportunity to learn about testing, algorithm design and building great RESTfull API.

Our backend stack is composed of Python, Node.js, Go, and C/C++. Our front-end is developed mostly in C# and React.

You will explore libraries like gtest, NetworkX, gdal, etc. We use Bitbucket, JIRA and Slack for team communication.

Moreover, in this start-up environment, you will acquire an entrepreneurial spirit and learn to be independent in your tasks. Your opinion will matter and you will be able to suggest new ideas to the team during the weekly staff meeting.
